The next General Meeting will be April 27th. Join us for dinner at around 6PM with the meeting kicking off around 6:30 and the world famous Carrows on Harbor Drive/Seaward in Ventura.

- Denise discussed the Oxnard Canine program and that officer Steve Trickle hopefully would be attending the VVR meeting to personally thank VVR for its contribution to the Oxnard Canine program. Officer Tripple did appear along with his working dog, Cody, a German shepherd. Oxnard Canine t-shirts were provided for VVR members who might want one.
- The NSRA Western Street Rod Nationals in Bakersfield is scheduled for April 24-25. VVR has made room reservations at the Residence Inn for anyone who may be interested in attending, in addition to the 10-12 people who have already indicated that they will be going. Plan is to meet at the 126 Café (Wells Road & the 126) at 9am to caravan to Bakersfield. Bob O indicated that Norris and Judy Woods have opened their home and will host a BBQ Saturday night.
- Potential May 2010 event: Ron indicated that he may be able to set up a tour of the Magnussen Supercharger facility. The Magnussen "Magnitude" is expected to be on display. We would need roughly 20 people to attend to make it worthwhile. Ron will try to set something up for either 8th or 22nd of May.
- Jim Fain offered a reminder that the Wheels and Waves car show in Santa Barbara is scheduled for 15-16 May. Jim is coordinating and will provide final plans later. There may be a conflict with the Good Guys 4th Orange County Get-Together being held on the same weekend. In order to attend both, some people are going to Orange County on 14 May, spending the night, and coming back 15 May then onto Santa Barbara on 16 May 2010. More details to follow.
- Chaz indicated that the VVR By-Laws were sent to those that didn't have copies, and that those By-Laws are less restrictive than previously written, in an attempt to attract younger members.
- At the April meeting the cars that will be on the flyer and t-shirt will be picked. Those member's cars that have been picked within the past 4 years are not eligible.

- Harbor Run Thoughts
 - Connie Fain has been doing the t-shirt procurement for a very long time and is opting out for this year. Sharon and Denise volunteered to replace Connie on t-shirt detail.
 - There was discussion concerning number of HR20 flyers to print. Jerry indicated that that last year for HR19, we had 10,000 total flyers printed and maybe had an inch to an inch and a half left over. Hard to guess quantity. This year, we'll have 7,500 printed.
 - Norris Woods agreed to again hand make the HR 20 Trophies. The member agreed to Need to send a check to Norris for purchase of raw materials for trophies.



- RaboBank has made a \$500 donation to VVR in support of HR20.
- There was again active discussion concerning the entry fee for HR20. The decision made that fee should remain \$20.00.
- There was discussion concerning what constitutes a primary sponsor. The decision was that a donation of \$1,500 constitutes a primary sponsor. A team will be contacting potential primary sponsor candidates for flyer purposes more than anything else right now. Magnussen is a definite. D'Angelo, Superior and Haas are "maybe's" that require a follow up.
