The Harbor Run Committee met at Carrows Restaurant on August 19th at 6:30pm. Topics discussed, action items, and follow on results are as follows:

- Trophies, Dash Plaques, Sponsor Awards have all been completed and are ready for the show thanks to Ron Cowan
- Members needed to get their T-Shirt orders into Connie Fain by no later than 15 August.
- Bob Osborne, Ron Cowan and I met with Michelle Gilmour and presented our plans and requests for HR-18. She needed to pass the parking and access issues to the Harbor Master for comment/Approval.
- The radio ad has been submitted and we are awaiting feedback from the harbor's PR team.
- Unfortunately the construction site is still there and will still be there on show day. The good news is, it has been reduced in size from last year.
- Ted Hetherington secured the Tables, chairs, and table coverings have been reserved from Ventura Rental Center.
- Instead of renting a truck, I made arrangements to use a 6x12 enclosed from U-Haul this year. The cost of the trailer is about ½ of the cost of the truck.
- The Nelsons have once again made a large donation to support our show. In addition to covering the costs of the homemade trophies. They also made arrangements to cover the cost of the tables, chairs, table coverings. Thank you, Elmore and Joy.
- Four Charities have been selected to receive checks on show day. They are Victory Outreach, Oxnard PAL, Oxnard Canine Unit, and Ventura Kiwanis.
- A special request from Dan Gresley's daughter Machala requesting VVR to sponsor her in a Jog-a-thon for her School. A unanimous vote to provide \$100.00 was passed.
- Thanks to Sharon Osborne, she has worked her magic once again and was able to get the requirement of having paid security waived. Way to go Sharon.
- Sharon Osborne and Lynn Perske have successfully obtained all the permits and paid the fees to allow us to put on our show. Cudos ladies, Great job!!!
- Bob Osborne has been working day and night to acquire vendors and other contributors for our show. Dan Gresley and Bob have formalized the layout of the vendors and have provided me with the final cut of sponsors and vendors to be included in our brochure.
- Show security has been an ongoing issue with the city. We hope to solicit support from several of the local police organizations. VVR will offer to provide vendor spaces to promote their public awareness as well. Oxnard PAL has indicated that they will be available to support our show.
- To sweeten the raffle table, any member who donates \$100.00 or more will receive an authentic genuine simulated Pewter and Gold Harbor Run 18 Sponsors plate. The more items on the table, the easier it will be to sell tickets and provide the foundation of funds to go to charity.

- Super Raffle items will be awarded using the following rules
 1. Super Raffle tickets will be sold for \$10.00/yard length (approx 20 tickets)
 2. Super Raffle tickets will be sold up to the Presentation of the Best in Show Award
 3. Reminders of the Super Raffle rules will be posted at the table and announced throughout the day.
 4. The first ticket pulled will be announced over the PA system and will be written on the white board with the exact time posted next to it.
 5. The holder of the winning ticket will have 2 minutes to come up and validate the ticket and make their selection from the prize table.
 6. If a claim is not made prior to the expiration time, the next ticket will be drawn and a new expiration time will be established
 7. This process will be repeated until all Super Prizes have been given out
 8. Must be present to win
- Regular Raffle Table Rules
 1. Regular Raffle tickets will be sold for \$5.00/yard (approx 20 tickets)
 2. Regular Raffle tickets will be sold up to 1:00pm
 3. At 1:00pm the final drawing of tickets to finish out the available prizes will be made
 4. Multiple announces via the PA system will be made pertaining the re-draws
 5. At 1:15pm, All unclaimed tickets/prizes remaining on the board will be erased
 6. Another batch of tickets will be drawn for the outstanding prizes (hopefully this will clear the board prior to the start of the award at 1:30)
 7. Reminders of the Regular Raffle rules will be posted at the table and announced throughout the day.
 8. Must be present to win
- 50/50 Raffle Rules
 1. 50/50 Raffle tickets will be sold for \$5.00/yard (approx 20 tickets)
 2. 50/50 Raffle tickets will be sold up to the Presentation of the Best in Show Award
 3. Reminders of the 50/50 Raffle rules will be posted at the table and announced throughout the day and immediately after the Super Raffle has completed
 4. Drawing of the 50/50 Raffle will commence after the Super Raffle prizes have been awarded.
 5. The first ticket pulled will be announced over the PA system only and will be repeated 3 times.
 6. The holder of the winning ticket will have approximately 30 seconds to come up and validate their ticket
 7. If a claim is not made prior to the expiration time, the next ticket will be drawn the process will be repeated until a winner has been selected
